Police Stations			
Avonmouth	To close and co-locate to a new station in Southmead. Beat surgeries nearby.	2016/17	The current enquiry office has a very low footfall so the local policing team will be co-located with the Southmead team. We are looking for a drop in facility nearby (possibly in Shirehampton) which will be used for appointments and regular beat surgeries.
Bishopsworth	To close and move to Broadbury Road	2016/17	The existing building is under-occupied as it was designed for a bigger team of people who have been more centrally located e.g. custody/CSI, and the enquiry office has very low footfall. The remaining teams will move down the road to Broadbury Road Police Station (2.3 miles away). We will look for a local space to host regular beat surgeries such as a local library or community space.
Brislington	To close and move to Broadbury Road	2015/16	The existing building is under-occupied - it was originally designed for more people - and the enquiry office has a very low footfall. The remaining teams will move down the road to Broadbury Road Police Station (3.5 miles away). We will look for a local space to host regular beat surgeries, including the possibility of using space in this building under new ownership.
Broadbury Road	Keep open and refurbish	2016/17	The enquiry office is well used and is a base for the local policing team. Once custody has been relocated there is potential for an extension to house partners and facilities for community use which could be part funded by Bristol City Council. The council are producing a feasibility study into its future use, including the possibility of it becoming a one-stop shop.

Fishponds	Keep open		Enquiry office and base for local policing team.
Southmead	To close and move to a new station nearby.	2016/17	Move enquiry office and policing base to a new station in Southmead. This will include the local Avonmouth policing team.
The Bridewell	Keep open		This is the flagship city centre police station and a base for local policing teams, district offices and one of our busiest enquiry offices. It is also home to IMPACT (Integrated Offender Management Programme), IRiS and other specialist support including partner agencies. Bristol City Council are also looking at the potential for The Bridewell to offer longer term opportunities for customer facing services.
Trinity Road	To close and move to a smaller location nearby.	2015/16	Custody will move to the new Patchway Police Centre in Summer 2014. The enquiry office, local policing and visual identification will move to new smaller location nearby. The current teams will remain until a new location is available. A location close by has been identified and discussions are progressing.

Keynsham Police Centre	New	Summer 2014	This newly built Police Centre will house 48 custody cells, specialist crime investigation teams, a multiagency safeguarding team and victim and witness focus team. It is likely to open in Summer 2014. The enquiry office will be located at another site in Keynsham (see below).
Patchway Police Centre	New	Summer 2014	This newly built Police Centre will include an enquiry office, 48 custody cells, crime investigation teams and local policing teams. It is likely to open in Summer 2014.

Bath	To close and co-locate with BANES on Manvers Street.	2017/18	A new Bath enquiry office and local policing base is to be co-located with the BaNES council on Manvers Street. A new Bath/North East base will open to include response, but a location is yet to be determined.

Filton	Closed and move to the new Patchway Police Centre		All departments will move to Patchway Police Centre, including custody, enquiry office and the South Glos local policing teams. Until the new police centre opens this summer, officers are temporarily located at Southmead with a few response officers operating out of Thornbury.
Keynsham	To close and co-locate with BANES in Town Hall.	Spring 2015	New Keynsham enquiry office and local policing base will be co-located with BaNES council in Town Hall, due to open Spring 2015.

Kingswood	Keep open		Enquiry office and base for local policing team co-located with South Gloucestershire Council in Kingswood Civic Centre. This successful co-location ensures visibility and accessibility to our local communities.
Radstock	To close and move to new facility nearby.	2016/17	A new Radstock enquiry office and local policing base will open in 2016/17. The location will be identified closer to the time and the current services will continue until a suitable location is available.

Bridgwater Police Centre	New	Summer 2014	The new Police Centre will house an enquiry office, which will be supplemented by a neighbourhood base in central Bridgwater. The new centre will include 36 custody cells, investigation teams, specialist operations, neighbourhood teams and CSI. It is due to open in Summer 2014.

Bridgwater	To close and move to new Police Centre in Bridgwater and a co-located station in centre.	Autumn 2014	Most teams will move to the new Bridgwater Police Centre but a new police station will open in the Sedgemoor council offices to keep a police presence in central Bridgwater. The local policing team will be based here along with a smaller enquiry service (staffed by council).
Burnham-on-Sea	To close and new station open nearby.	2014/15	A new Burnham police station will open with enquiry office and local policing base. There is potential for co-location with Devon and Somerset Fire and Rescue, subject to funding.
Chard	To close and move to smaller base.	2016/17	We are looking for a smaller base for the local policing team. The team will remain and current services will continue until a new location is opened.
Cheddar	To close and move to smaller base.	2016/17	We are looking for a smaller base for the local policing team. The team will remain and current services will continue until a new location is opened.
Clevedon	Keep open as co-location with North Somerset Council		A shared location with North Somerset Council in Clevedon houses the local policing team and enquiry office.

Crewkerne	To close and open new local policing base.	2017/18	A new Crewkerne police office will be opened to house the local policing team. A base nearby, including possible co-location is being sought.
Frome	To close and move to nearby temporary location before a new response hub is built on the existing site.	May 2014 (closes) New hub opens in 2015/16	A new Frome Police Station, housing the enquiry office and local policing team, will open as a co-location with Frome library to ensure the best visibility and accessibility. A new Frome response base will be built on part of the existing Frome Police Station site. Until then, response will be temporarily based at Wessex Fields (2.5years).
Minehead	To close and co-locate nearby.	2016/17	A new co-located site housing the enquiry office and policing team is planned.
Nailsea	To close and new Station to open nearby.	2015/16	A new Nailsea Police Station will open, housing an enquiry office and local policing team. We are exploring an opportunity to co-locate with North Somerset Council in an easily accessible leisure facility.
Somerton	To close and new base to open.	2017/18	A new Somerton police office will open housing the local policing team.
Street	To close and new station to open nearby.	2017/18	A new Street police station will open containing an enquiry office and local policing base. We are exploring an opportunity to co-locate with fire and ambulance services, subject to funding.
Taunton	To close custody and move to Bridgwater Police Centre. A new local police station to open in Taunton.	2015/16	A new Taunton police station will open including an enquiry office, local policing base and response unit, co-located with local council. The location is yet to be finalised, but the station will not close until a new location is confirmed. Our custody and investigatory teams will move to new Bridgwater Police Centre.
Wellington	Keep open		The station will continue to house the enquiry office and base for local policing team.

Wells	Keep open		The station will continue to house the enquiry office and base for local policing team. A new site will be needed in the future.
Weston Super Mare	To close and new response hub to open. Co-located local policing base at Town Hall.	New response hub opens 2016/17	The local policing base and enquiry office is already located at WSM Town Hall co-located with North Somerset Council. A new response hub will open on the outskirts of WSM. A site has been identified near Junction 21 to enable good access to the local area.
Williton	To close and co-locate with Minehead.	2016/17	The enquiry office and local policing base will move to Minehead and we plan to hold regular meetings at Williton.
Wincanton (Churchfields)	Keep the co-location open		The enquiry office will remain co-located with South Somerset Council.
Yeovil Police Station	To close and new local policing base to open.	2016/17	A new Yeovil police station will open including the enquiry office and local policing base. We are exploring an opportunity to co-locate with Somerset County Council. A site for a new South East Custody Centre is currently under negotiation.
