So under the Freedom Of Information Act can I ask the A&S PCC Office (not the the Constabulary), seeing as it clearly came up with the idea of reviewing the Injury Of Duty Pensioners, to supply me with copies of any correspondence relating to what has been saved or spent in addition on IOD pension and what has actually been spent on the reviews to date.

Response:
