

FREEDOM OF INFORMATION REQUEST – FOI 689

FOI Request:

Can you provide details of / copies of any documentation, email, reports etc, either digital or hard copy from within the last 3 years that is held by the PCC in relation to;

- 1 - the ending of the review of injury on duty pension
- 2 - the Injury On Duty Pensioners Association / IODPA (<https://iodpa.org/>)
- 3 - Operation Hitherto.

Answer:

Regarding item 1, please see the response to you in references FOI663 and FOI669, published on the PCC's website.

In addition to this response, please be advised that the cost of providing you with the full information requested is above the amount to which we are legally required to respond i.e. the cost of searching for, locating and retrieving the information exceeds the "appropriate level" as stated in the Freedom of Information (Fees and Appropriate Limit) Regulations 2004. It is estimated that it would cost at least £450 to comply with your request, including checking all documentation – electronic and hard copy, in the office and in archive - and all available emails for the last 3 years – either financial years or calendar years – searching for the narrative you mention, being "Injury On Duty Pensioners Association", "IODPA", "<https://iodpa.org/>" or "Operation Hitherto".

In accordance with the Freedom of Information Act 2000, this letter acts as a Refusal Notice in this respect.
