Terms of Appointment

Appointment

The appointment will be subject to satisfactory references and will also be subject to security vetting clearance.

Term

The appointment will be for a two year fixed term contract from April 2019. Any extensions to this term shall require the approval of the Police & Crime Commissioner and the funding partners.

The written notice period for termination of the appointment is three months by either party.

Base salary

The salary per annum will be £39,918 - £42,918 depending on experience and will be pro rata for the part-time role. Salary is paid on a monthly basis.

The Post

The post holder will be required to travel across the Avon and Somerset region. The post holder should have access to a vehicle or be able to make alternative arrangements to meet the requirements of the post.

The post holder must recognise the importance of managing information according to legal requirements and quality standards.

It is expected that the post holder supports the Principles of Standards in Public Life. As such, the seven principles of conduct underpin the work of the PCC and are used as the basis for working practices.

Place of Work

The workplace will split between the Office of the Police & Crime Commissioner and the Constabulary, Valley Road, Portishead, Bristol or Bridewell police centre in central Bristol.

Reporting Lines

The post holder will report to the OPCC CEO and to the Criminal Justice Board Steering Group.

Hours of work

The post holder is required to work 4 days per month.
