## Decision Title: YEOVIL POLICE STATION: NEIGHBOURHOOD AND ENQUIRY OFFICE

## **Decision summary:**

To move the neighbourhood policing team and the police enquiry office out of Yeovil Police Station and into Yeovil fire station.

The decision was taken to retain our focus on frontline policing, make significant savings and provide better opportunities of working together with the fire service.

## Background or reference to supporting papers:

The emerging Estates Strategy provides for the disposal of the 3472m<sup>2</sup> Yeovil Police Station and the provision of a new neighbourhood base within a partner organisation. The new premises will provide a home for Yeovil's neighbourhood base and, Enquiry Office.

The rationale for this strategy includes for the disposal of <u>all</u> old oversized, inefficient stations and provide local alternative accommodation solutions that are smaller, more efficient to run whilst at the same time ensuring neighbourhood policing teams always remain within neighbourhoods and where appropriate share space with partners to include Blue Light Services.
