Decision Title: Restorative Justice Provision

Decision summary:

To fund Bristol Mediation - as the lead partner, working in collaboration with Bristol Neighbourhood Justice Partnership - to deliver Restorative Justice provision across Avon and Somerset from 1st June 2017 until the end of March 2019.

Background or reference to supporting papers:

At the Police and Crime Board in November 2016 it was agreed that a 12 week period would be set aside to enable all current RJ delivery partners funded by the OPCC to develop proposals for the future provision of Restorative Justice across Avon and Somerset (to commence from the 1st June 2017), against a set of clearly outlined criteria. These proposals were considered by a specially convened panel in early February and the panel's recommendation is that Bristol Mediation - as the lead partner, working in collaboration with Bristol Neighbourhood Justice Partnership - be funded to deliver the service from 1st June 2017 until the end of March 2019. Costs for delivery of this service are £150,000 from 1st June 2017 to the end of March 2018 and £179,000 for the period 1st April 2018 to the end of March 2019. This provides savings of £60,000 and £74,000 respectively.
