Decision Title: Appointment of Senior Responsible Officer for Criminal Justice Service Transformation

Decision summary:

To agree funding of £75,000 over 2 years to provide match funding for the appointment of a co-funded Senior Responsible Officer for Criminal Justice Service Transformation.

Background or reference to supporting papers:

The PCC, in partnership with the A&S Criminal Justice Board, secured Home Office Police Transformation Funding to conduct a review with the aim to transform a disjointed local criminal justice system into a streamlined and victim-focused local criminal justice service. The review completed in May 2017.

The Police and Crime Commissioner has committed £75,000 over a two year period to provide match funding for the appointment of a Senior Responsible Officer to develop and deliver a programme of work to take forward recommendations of the review and complementary workstreams with the aim to transform the local criminal service and improve the experience of victims. Co-funding over a two-year period has been agreed by partners as follows:

- £20,000 each Avon and Somerset Constabulary, Crown Prosecution Service and HM Courts and Tribunal Service
- £15.000 HMP Bristol

A Memorandum of Understanding has been agreed by partners with respect to the co-funding arrangements. The post-holder will report to the Criminal Justice Transformation Project Steering Group, with oversight by the Avon and Somerset Criminal Justice Board.
