Decision Title: Appointment of members to the Scrutiny of Police Powers Panel.

Decision summary:

The PCC has run a recruitment process to appoint volunteers to be part of a scrutiny panel looking at the use of police powers. The panel will regularly review the use of police powers including stop and search, Taser, Body Worn Cameras and use of force. The panel will 'dip-sample' case files as a method of scrutinising the use of police powers
