**Decision Title: Contract extension for Victim Services** 

## **Decision summary:**

To extend the contracts of the victim services initially commissioned from April 2015 by one year (1<sup>st</sup> April 2018 – 31<sup>st</sup> March 2019).

## Background or reference to supporting papers:

A number of providers (listed below) currently deliver a range of victim services that initially commenced from April 2015. The service was commissioned for a three year period, with the option to extend for one additional year.

- Emotional Support Service (Victim Support) £296,973 p.a
- Avoice Adult Advocacy Service (The Care Forum working with SEAP and SARI) - £329,467.42
- Young Victims' Service (North Somerset Youth Offending Service) -£165,000
- Independent Sexual Violence Advisor Service (Safelink) £194,580
- Modern Slavery Support Service (Unseen) £38,513

Avon and Somerset Police & Crime Commissioner

This decision is to take up the option to extend the services for the additional one year period, until the 31<sup>st</sup> March 2019, at the cost outlined above.

Significant work will need to be undertaken to recommissioning these services from September 2017, with initial planning work already having taken place.
