Decision Title: Joining the Multi Force Shared Service

Decision summary:

In March 2015 the Constabulary announced that it would not extend its existing contract for services with Southwest One when it expires in June 2018. Consequently, in April 2016, the Constabulary began to consider its options in relation to the future provision of associated services and systems from June 2018.

As a result of this options appraisal it has been determined the Constabulary will join the Multi Force Shared Service (MFSS) and proceed with implementation of the associated shared services and Oracle tPolice system.

To achieve this, the Constabulary will enter a Section 22a agreement under The Police Act 1996, with Cheshire, Northamptonshire, Nottinghamshire and Civil Nuclear Forces.

The Constabulary will now agree a schedule of work with MFSS, third party providers and internal stakeholders with a view to moving to the Oracle tPolice system in April 2018.
