Decision Title: Victim Services Recommissioning

Decision summary:

To approve the award of contracts to across the five lots of victim services that were recently recommissioned and will go live on 1st April 2019

Background or reference to supporting papers:

The OPCC first commissioned a range of services to support victims of crime and anti-social behaviour in 2014. These were commissioned for an initial three year period, with an option to extend for a further year (which was activated). As a result preparation work began in late 2017 to recommissioning these services, in order to be ready to go live on 1st April 2019.

A Victims Recommissioning Governance Board was established, with representation from the Senior Leadership Team of the OPCC, Constabulary, Police and Crime Panel and Voscur. The Board has overseen the process, providing support and challenge and signing off all the key decisions at the various milestones throughout the process.

The recommissioning process included the development of a victim needs assessment (undertaken by an external provider), significant consultation and engagement on the commissioning intentions and commissioning plan and service user engagement throughout the process (led and facilitated by a an external provider). Further information on the process can be found on the OPCC website.

The attached "Victims Award 419" provides further information on the procurement aspect of the commissioning process.
