Decision Title: Reveal Body Worn Video Camera Refresh

Decision summary:

The Constabulary seeks approval to proceed with the preferred option identified within the Body Worn Video Camera (BWVC) Refresh Business Case as presented and endorsed at the March 2020 Constabulary Management Board. The option recommends re-procuring BWVCs and associated licences and support with Reveal Media, extending the current agreement post November 2020, for 3 years.

Background or reference to supporting papers:

Reveal's commercial offering for approval as detailed in the BWVC Refresh Business Case is £1,914,626. Additional estimated Cloud storage costs for the 3 year period are £205,972, making a total of £2,120,598. The contract is to begin on 01/12/20.
