Taking into account the design costs including reasonable estimates of time taken, printing and postage out and in, website set up, and likely costs to analyse results, please can you tell me the estimated cost of this exercise to the nearest ten thousand pounds. I don't want this FOI to take up more unnecessary time so ballpark figure will do.

Our response:

In relation to your question concerning The Police and Crime Survey, the packaging, post and return envelopes for the postal survey cost a total of £15,088

The cost of the design of the paper survey by the graphic design agency was £510.

There were no additional costs recorded.
