Avon and Somerset Police and Crime Commissioner's (PCC's) office have now completed the search for the information which you requested on the 20th December 2021.

Your request:

Police tax survey

I want to know how much the 2% and 4.1% respectively would raise in total for the budget?

Our response:

A rise in the policing part of the precept next year by £10 for a Band D household (equivalent to 4.1%) would result in an additional £5.77 million pounds.

A 2% increase (£4.82 for the year) for a Band D household, would result in an additional £2.79 million pounds.
