RE: FREEDOM OF INFORMATION REQUEST – FOI954 34142

Avon and Somerset Police and Crime Commissioner's (PCC's) office have now completed the search for the information which you requested on the 16th January 2023.

Your request:

I am requesting data regarding the makeup of the surveys conducted on the public in 2021 and 2022 in relation to the council tax precept for policing.

Specifically, I wish to know the total number of respondents for each year and how many respondents were employed by the Constabulary or OPCC.

Our response:

In 2021 we had 2884 responses. In this survey we did not ask if respondents were employed by the police.

In 2022 we had 5605 responses of which 1440 respondents (25.7%) declared they were employed by the police. There was not a separate question about whether staff were employed by the OPCC.
