Avon and Somerset Police and Crime Commissioner's (PCC's) office have now completed the search for the information which you requested on the 29th March 2023.

Your request:

1. The number of services commissioned by the Office of the Police and Crime Commissioner in the past 12 months for:

a. Child Victims of Child Criminal Exploitation

b. Child Victims of Child Sexual Exploitation.

Our response:

1

a. The OPCC contributed to 2 locality responses to CCE across the force area (Bristol and Somerset ROUTES delivered by Barnardos')

b. The OPCC co-commissioned (with 5 local authorities) a forcewide response to CSE (Banardo's against sexual exploitation)

Please be advised these services are now part of an Avon and Somerset re-modelling of local authority response to child exploitation (including both CSE/CCE), therefore the arrangements as described above ceased on 31/03/23 and are now going to be delivered through local authority re-modelling and in re-commissioning of services. The OPCC will be committing to funding these new ways of delivery an exploitation response.
