

PCC DECISION REF 2023/003

Decision Title: Yeovil Horsey Lane Police Station

Decision summary:

The Constabulary seeks approval to proceed with the preferred option identified with the Yeovil Outline Business Case as presented and endorsed at the March Constabulary Management Board held on 30th March 2023 and the subsequent Governance Scrutiny Board held on 11th April. This option recommends the substantial refurbishment of existing premises at Horsey Lane, Yeovil.

Background or reference to supporting papers:

The preferred option for a police station in Yeovil is to refurbish existing premises at Horsey Lane and, once complete, relinquish the lease at Brympton Way and move back teams who have been temporarily located there. This will provide a hub police station in Yeovil providing a range of frontline and specialist functions. including an Enquiry Office, Response policing, Neighbourhood policing, Criminal Investigation and Operations.

The project is estimated to cost £5.3M - £6.4M based on a feasibility study completed in November 2022.
