Please provide the breakdown of figures for the last ten years (I couldn't find this on your websites so if you have already posted this clearly please advise as to what the link or section is).

Our response:

We can confirm that the information related to your request is already available in the public domain and therefore falls within the s21 exemption of the Freedom of Information Act. Section 21 is an absolute and class-based exemption and as such does not require a harm and public interest test.
