Under the Freedom of Information Act 2000, I am writing to request information regarding crime prevention funding and partnership strategies within Taunton.

Please provide the following information:

Community Safety and Prevention Grants: Information on any Police and Crime Grants, Community Safety Partnership funding, or local prevention funds awarded to community projects, warm spaces, or food intervention initiatives in Taunton over the last 24 months.

Partnership Working: Copies of any strategy documents or policy frameworks regarding collaboration with local voluntary sector organisations to reduce social isolation and support vulnerable residents in Taunton.

If any of this information is already published, please provide the direct web links to the relevant documents.

Our response:
