Appendix 1: Terminology

“body in which the relevant person has a beneficial interest” means a firm in which the relevant person is a partner or a body corporate of which the relevant person is a director, or in the securities of which the relevant person has a beneficial interest;

“director” includes a member of the committee of management of an industrial and provident society;

“land” includes an easement, servitude, interest or right in or over land which does not carry with it a right for the relevant person (alone or jointly with another) to occupy the land or to receive income;

“elected local policing body” means the Avon and Somerset elected Local Policing Body, to which the ‘relevant person’ has been elected.

“relevant person” means the person who is elected/appointed Police and Crime Commissioner who is making this notification of disclosable interest.

“relevant period” means the period of 12 months ending with the day on which the relevant person makes an entry, amendment or deletion to the register of disclosable interest.

“securities” means shares, debentures, debenture stock, loan stock, bonds, units of a collective investment scheme within the meaning of the Financial Services and Markets Act 2000 and other securities of any description, other than money deposited with a building society.
